3. IT Project

IT Project identified 4 stages:

- 1) New Infrastructure in terms of cabling to improve direct Internet connection to Class 1
 - This has been completed and funded from Capital Expenditure
- 2) New Devices to improve experience within classrooms

- New Laptops for staff and Class 2 children plus new Tablets for Class 1 all in place and funded by FOLS and PE budget
- Additional set up fees from IT Support budget will be part funded by refund of circa £3k for old IT equipment.
- 3) Julie and staff to ensure that IT becomes fully integrated into the curriculum and lesson plans
- 4) Replacement Server needed which will be included within budgets for next financial yar.

New phone system has also been installed in prep for changes to phone lines. No cost to change and ongoing costs within budget.

4. I&E Report

Ran through current I&E report with Nicki who identified any variances to budget. At this stage, budget on track with only a few minor variances. NN identified some future expenditure that wasn't included within budgets for this year:

Boiler – needs replacing but this should be covered by Wiltshire

Tree Surgeon - £800 to sort out trees within grounds

Fencing - £8k – assuming Wilts confirm in Feb that not included within budgets again.

5. AOB

NN advised that they had changed supplier for Grounds Maintenance as they weren't getting a good service from old provider. They have gone for a new local supplier and other than tree surgeon this will fall within budgets for the year.
