4. Budget Monitoring

Governors Training Allowance will now be noted in the Budget under Staff Training cost centre so that there is transparency on the percentage of costs being spent on Governors training.

Sign off Threshold – this was reviewed and the following process and limits were agreed: NN to obtain 3 quotes or Kier approved suppliers for each job to be carried out

Day to day £1500 limit – NN and/or JG can approve £1501 - £2999 – NN and/or JG with approval of Finance Committee Above £3000 – approval will be required by FGB

NN identified some future expenditure that wasn't included within budgets for this year: Pay Rise Teachers – there will be a deficit on the budget as 3% paid for by LA, 3.5% paid for by the school. Support Staff pay increase not supported by LA at all therefore all from School Budget. Supply Staff – there will be a deficit, as our Insurance does not cover all of the costs.
